ter upon the duties of his office immediately on the passage of this act and to close the same as soon thereafter as possible.

SEC. 4. That the person so appointed shall receive for the services herein required to be performed, such compensation to [be] paid out of the territorial Treasury as the Legislative Assembly may deem proper.

## AN ACT relating to certain streets in the city of Milwaukee.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Section 1. The president and board of trustees of the town of Milwaukee, or the aldermen of the third ward of the city of Milwaukee, are hereby authorized and empowered to levy a special tax on the lots fronting each side of Main Street, between Huron Street and the Milwaukee tiver, for the purpose of grading said street, and the special tax so levied shall not exceed two-thirds of the costs of said improvement, and may be collected at the same time, and in the same manner as the general tax of said town or city.

SEC. 2. The president and the board of trustees of the town of Milwaukee, or the aldermen of the fifth ward of the city of Milwaukee, are hereby authorized and empowered to extend and grade South Water Street, and levy a special tax on the real estate benefitted thereby; and the special tax so levied shall not exceed three fourths of the costs of said improvement, and may be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the general tax of said town or city.
