AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Fairplay," approved February 21, 1845.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That all of section number twenty-five, in township No. one, of range No. two west of the fourth principal meridian, in the county of Grant, shall hereafter be known as the village of Fairplay; and the inhabitants residing; or who may hereafter reside on the said section, are hereby constituted a body corporate by the name of "the trustees of the village of Fairplay;" and by that name they and their successors forever hereafter shall and may have perpetual succession, and be capable in law of suing and being sued, pleading and being impleaded, answering and being answered unto, defending and being defended in all courts and places and in all suits whatsoever.

SEC. 2. Section one, of an act entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Fairplay," approved February 24, 1845, is hereby tepsaled; and the preceding section is enacted in the place of the said repealed section.
