AN ACT repealing an act which vacated an alley in Southport.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That an act entitled "an act relating to an alley in the village of Southport," approved February 24, 1845, be and the same is hereby repealed; and that so much of an alley as lies east of lot number sixteen, in block number ninety-two, in the north ward of said village of Southport, is hereby declared to be a public highway, in the same manner and to the same effect that the same was before the passage of the act hereby repealed.

APPROVED February 2, 1846.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of the account of J. Gillett Knapp against the Territory.

SECTION 1. There shall be allowed and paid to J. Gillet Knapp out of the territorial treasury, one hundred dollars for services rendered in suit of the Territory vs. J. D. Doty and others, at the July term in the Supreme Court in 1844, and for services in attending District Court in Iowa county, to prepare new declaration in cause, by order of court, which sum shall be in full for all services rendered to the Territory to this date.
