tax on the assessment roll of said district, in addition to the amount now allowed by law of a sum not exceeding two hundred dollars for the purpose of building a school house.

SEC. 2. That the said tax shall be levied, collected, and returned in the same manner that is now provided by law for the collection of taxes for building school houses: *Provided*, that a majority of the legal voters in said school district, who may be present at a school meeting called for that purpose by the trustees, thereof, who shall give at least ten days' notice of the said meeting by posting up notices in three or more conspicuous, places within the limits of the district, shall vote in favor of levying the tax authorized by this act.

AN ACT for the establishment of a territorial road from Burlington, in Racine county, to Delevan, in Walworth county.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That there shall be laid out and established a territorial road from Burlington, in Racine county, on the most practicable route, to Delevan, in Walworth county; and that William C. Allen, John R. Kendall and Sewall Smith be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish the same.

SEC. 2. That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
