SEC. 2. The inhabitants of said town of Prairie du Chien shall have the right to work out the poll tax assessed upon them, upon said highway, between the old French village and St. Friole.

AN ACT

To legalize the acts of Daniel Pirece.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the official acts of Daniel Pierce, of the town of Hudson, in the county of Walworth, as commissioner of highways, during the years 1845, and 1846, shall be as legal and valid as if he had been duly elected and qualified, and his said acts shall not be questioned, or deemed invalid for any informality, or illegality in his election or appointment.
