## AN ACT

To authorize the taxation of personal property in the township of Sun Prairie, in the county of Dane.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Section 1. That in the township of Sun Prairie, in the What propcounty of Dane aforesaid, in addition to the property now erty to be subject to taxation by law, the following property shall be assessed and taxed in the same manner as is now provided by law, for all purposes, to wit: All improvements on lands, town lots, and real estate, and all personal property, (and the term personal property, as used in this act, shall be construed to include monies, goods, chattels personal and chattels real, debts due from solvent debtors over and above the amount of debts owing by the owner thereof, whether due on account, contracts, note, bond, or mortgage, public stock or stocks in corporations:) Provided, that the following property shall be exempt from taxation in said township, to wit: All property belonging to this territory, all buildings for public worship, and all school houses, and the lots whereon they are situated, and all interest or shares in the same, and all property exempted by law from taxation.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
