cates or estimates of work done, under said Anderson's contract, as specified in the first section of this act.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT

To divorce Caleb Croswell from his wife E. Jane Croswell.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the marriage contract between Caleb Croswell and his wife É. Jane Croswell, of Walworth county, is hereby dissolved, and the parties to the said contract, are, by virtue of this act, restored to all the rights and privileges of unmarried persons.
