to Foxville, in said Racine county, heretofore laid out by Horatio C. Train and David W. Burnham, viewers appointed by the board of county commissioners of said county, a minute of the survey of which was recorded in the book of records of the proceedings of said board of county commissioners, April 1, 1839, be and the same is hereby declared to be a legal and valid highway.

AN ACT

To vacate a part of a territorial road.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That so much of a territorial road leading from Whitewater to Madison, as is situated between Koskonong creek, and the west half of section twenty, in township number six, north of range number twelve east, in the county, of Dane, be and the same is hereby vacated, and hereafter shall not be used as a public highway.
