AN ACT

To authorize school district No. 1, in Richmond, and 6, in Johnstown, to renew a tax warrant, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives. of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the trustees of joint school district number one, in the town of Richmond, Walworth county, and number six, in the town of Johnstown, Rock county, are hereby authorized to renew a tax warrant, issued for the collection of one hundred and eighty-five dollars, which was ordered to be raised at their last annual meeting, for the purpose of building a school house.

SEC. 2. The acts of the commissioners of schools in organizing the school district named in the first section of this act, are hereby sanctioned and legalized.
