AN ACT

To authorize the Adjutant General to draw on the Treasurer for money to meet certain expenses.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Adjutant General may draw drafts on Treasurer.

Section 1. That the treasurer of the territory is hereby authorized to pay on the draft of the adjutant general, such sum or sums of money as may be necessary to meet the expenditures of that office, authorized by law, not exceeding three hundred and twenty-five dollars; for the faithful expenditure of which the adjutant general shall account with the auditor of the territory, and make report to the next legislature.
