AN ACT

To amend an act entitled "An act to provide for the destruction of wolves,"

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Section 1. That section first of the act to which this act is amendatory, be so amended as to authorize the board of county commissioners or board of supervisors of the several counties in this territory, to regulate the bounty on wolves, and to offer such rewards for the destruction of wolves in their respective counties as they may deem proper.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Lake Michigan and Mississippi Rail Road Company.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:
