AN ACT appropriating to Wallace Mygatt a sum therein named.

The sum of thirty-four dollars is hereby appropriated to Wallace Mygatt to be paid out of the state treasury in full compensation for papers furnished the late constitutional convention: for publishing the constitution of the state of Wisconsin and for publishing the proclamation of the governor convening the legislature.

There is hereby appropriated to Leech and Springer the sum of eight dollars for furnishing papers to the last territorial legislature (being the same amount erroneously allowed to Lake and Sprague by an act of appropriation approved March 13th 1848 and not drawn) in full of all accounts against the state.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to S. L. Rood the sum of thirty-five dollars and fifty cents for furnishing blocks of Record for the office of the secretary of state and in full of all accounts against the state of Wisconsin up to this date.
