consin may receive from the government of the United States under the provisions of the several acts of Congress providing for arming and equiping the whole body of the militia of the United States. He shall require the officers to whom such arms or equipments are distributed and delivered to execute to the state of Wisconsin a bond with two sufficient sureties to be approved by him in the penal sum, as near as may be, of double the value of said arms or equipments, conditioned for the sefe keeping and redelivery of the same on the order of the governor.
