AN ACT

To legalize a school tax in Phelps school district number three in Germantown, Washington county, and authorize said district to levy an additional tax to build a school house.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Tax declared legal.

Section 1. That the tax of one hundred and ten dollars levied in Phelps school district number three in Germantown, Washington county, for building a school house, is hereby declared to be legal and valid, and that said tax be collected and accounted for in the same manner as other school district taxes: Provided, that the legal voters of said district at any meeting legally convened shall vote to confirm said assessment.

Additional tax to be levied.

SEC. 2. The trustees of said Phelps school district number three are hereby authorized to levy an additional tax upon the taxable property in said district, not to exceed ninety dollars, to be applied to the building of a school house in said district.

How collected. Sec. 3. The said tax shall be levied and collected in the same manner as now provided by law for the collection of taxes: *Provided*, that the legal voters of said district vote to raise such sum in the manner now provided by law.
