AN ACT

To dissolve the marriage contract between Orman Crandall and Angeline Crandall.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Section 1. That the marriage contract heretofore existing between Orman Crandall and Angeline Crandall be, and the same is hereby dissolved, and the parties to the said contract are by virtue of this act restored to all the rights and privileges of unmarried persons
