CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT to create 66.91 of the statutes, authorizing counties, cities, villages and towns to aid in the development of housing for veterans and servicemen.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.91 of the statutes is created to read:

66.91 HOUSING FOR VETERANS; AUTHORITY TO PROMOTE; STATE COOPERATION. (1) Any county, city, village or town or agency thereof may appropriate money, grant the use of land, buildings or property owned or leased by it, or take such other action as may be deemed advisable or necessary to promote and provide housing for veterans and servicemen.

(2) In the event that an agency created or designated by a county or municipality to administer anything authorized under this section is unable to secure satisfactory and acceptable bid or bids the agency may nevertheless negotiate necessary contracts authorized by the sponsoring county or municipality subject to the approval of the county or municipality.

(3) The state department of veterans' affairs is authorized and directed to furnish any county, city, village, town or agency thereof with information and assistance to facilitate housing for veterans and servicemen and said department shall call upon the state planning board for assistance in carrying out the purpose of this subsection. The state planning board shall furnish such assistance when requested and the salaries and expenses therefor shall be paid out of the appropriation for the state department of veterans' affairs.
