CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT to create 20.74 (2) of the statutes, appropriating additional funds to the emergency board for the execution of its functions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.74 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

20.74 (2) In addition to the appropriation made in subsection (1) for the fiscal year 1946-1947, \$1,821,600 for the period ending February 28, 1947, to be allotted as provided in subsection (1) to the following departments for the purposes and in the maximum amounts as follows:
