**Senate amendment 1 to Assembly Bill 115**

In enrolling, the following correction was made:

1. Page 1, line 3: delete "the material inserted on".

**Senate amendment 2 to Assembly Bill 160**

In enrolling, the following corrections were made:

1. Page 1, line 6: move lines 6 and 7 after line 10, and substitute "5" for "4".
2. Page 1, line 8: substitute "4" for "5"; and substitute "20" for "21".

**Assembly Bill 247**

In enrolling, the following corrections were made to give effect to Senate Amendments 11 and 13:

1. Senate Amendment 11: The substitution of "affected" for "impaired on the job" was incorporated into the text substituted by Senate Amendment 10 (page 1, lines 12 and 13) for the insertion by Assembly

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Amendment 2 (page 1, line 4) on page 2, line 15, of the bill as shown by Assembly Substitute Amendment 1.

2. Senate Amendment 13: On page 1 of this amendment, on line 3 and on line 6, delete the word "insert" and replace that word with the phrase below so as to give effect to Senate Amendment 13 which was the last amendment adopted by the senate and the last amendment concurred in by the assembly: "delete the

material beginning with ", if the employee", which was there inserted by Senate Amendment 10, and substitute".

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 to **Assembly Bill 658**

In enrolling, the following correction was made:

1. In Assembly Amendment 1 to Assembly Amendment 2, on page 1, line 3, substitute "if the" for "to".
