Pursuant to action taken by the Board of Regents during its regular monthly meeting on April 10, 1992, I am transmitting the Design for Diversity Progress Report as required under s. 36.25(14m)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The 1990-91 Design for Diversity Progress Report fulfills the requirement in Section 36.25(14m)(b) of the Wisconsin State Statutes that the Board of Regents report annually on its precollege, recruitment and retention plan for minority and disadvantaged students enrolled in the System. This report must also include information on financial aid programs serving minority and disadvantaged students. The report includes information concerning:

- 1) New student recruitment and retention
2) Minority faculty and staff hiring
3) Student financial assistance
4) Financial expenditures for minority and disadvantaged student programs, and
