Executive Order Number 156

Relating to Amending Executive Orders #154 and #155 (dated 8/13/92 and 8/14/92), Scheduling a Special Session of the Legislature

I, Tommy G. Thompson, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this state, and specifically by Article IV, Section 11 and Article V, Section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend Executive Orders #154 and #155 (dated 8/13/92 and 8/14/92), which required the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on Tuesday, August 25, 1992, solely to consider certain nominations for appointment by the Governor requiring confirmation by the Senate as follows:

- 1. The scope of the Special Session shall be expanded to also include consideration presently of the amount of certain public debt authorizations and granting bonding authority for the sole purpose of refunding existing state debt.*

- 2. Executive Order #155 shall be corrected to change the effective date from January 14, 1992 to August 14, 1992.*
