Pursuant to the requirements of section 153.10(1), Wis. Stat., we are pleased to submit to the Governor and the Legislature the quarterly Health Care Data Report. This report is based on hospital inpatient discharge data reported to the Office of Health Care Information by all operating general medical-surgical and specialty hospitals in Wisconsin for the fourth quarter of 1993 (October - December).
