

NR 10.32, Wis. Adm. Code Modification of the duck hunting zone

Board Order No. WM-46-95

Statement of Need

Clearinghouse Rule No. 95-196 included proposed changes in both the duck zone boundary and early Canada goose subzone boundary. Four public hearings were held from December 11 to December 14, 1995. The Conservation Congress asked the Department to delay action on the proposed early Canada goose subzone until after the 1996 Spring Hearings in April. That proposal will be processed as Clearinghouse Rule No. 95-196.

In 1990, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service announced that beginning in 1991, duck zone boundaries would be frozen for 5-year periods. The Department may change the duck zones in 1996 or keep the current zones. Either way, the zones will again be frozen for 5 years and the next change will not be allowed until the year 2001. If Wisconsin wishes to modify the duck zone, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service must be provided the desired modification by April 15, 1996.

Modifications as a Result of Public Hearing

The boundaries of the duck zone changes shifted Northwestern Wisconsin into the Southern Duck Zone. The duck zone boundary in northwestern Wisconsin will be highway 27, county highway B around the Chippewa Flowage in Sawyer County, and then highway 77 west to the Wisconsin-Minnesota state line. The current duck zone boundary is highway 10. Most of Kewaunee County and all of Door County will be placed in the Southern Duck Zone and Brown County will remain in the Northern Duck Zone.


Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.174(2) and 29.085, Stats.

In this order:

Section 1. Duck zone - modifies the duck hunting zone. The current duck zone boundary is highway 10. The new zone boundary will shift northwestern Wisconsin into the Southern Duck Zone. The duck zone boundary in northwestern Wisconsin will be highway 27, county highway B around the Chippewa Flowage in Sawyer County, and then highway 27 west to the Wisconsin-Minnesota state line. Most of Kewaunee County and all of Door County will be placed in the Southern Duck Zone.

NR 10.32 is repealed and recreated to read: SECTION 1.
