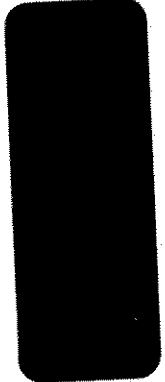

Dear Chairman Duff,

Enclosed are letters from forty-three of your constituents urging you to vote in favor of the Mining Moratorium Bill (SB3/AB 70) and against any efforts to weaken the bill as passed by the Senate.

Wisconsin Citizen Action and its 52, 867 individual members statewide are very concerned about the potential impact of allowing Exxon to develop North America's largest metallic sulfide mine at the headwaters of the Wolf River. We believe the technology should be proven safe before we risk our groundwater, the rivers in which our families fish and recreate, and the lifeblood of Wisconsin's \$6.6 billion tourism industry.

As passed by the Senate, the Mining Moratorium bill does not ban all mining. The bill addresses one particular type of mining, metallic sulfide mining, of which we believe there are no safe examples in the United States. AB70/SB3 postpones opening a new metallic sulfide mine in Wisconsin until there is proof of a similar mine operating for ten years and being closed and reclaimed for ten years without causing contamination of ground or surface water. The bill clearly defines the criteria for comparison.

Exxon and Rio Algom claim that there are already six examples of safe metallic sulfide mines operating in North America. Based on research we have studied, these mines do not yet meet the criteria -- some are still open, others have not been reclaimed long enough, at least one is in carbonate rock which does not produce acid, and several, including the Flambeau Mine, did not perform milling or chemical processing on site (hence the potential for acid producing waste did not exist there). However, the criteria in AB70/SB3 may be met eventually.

Either way, AB70/SB3 makes sense. If metallic sulfide mines meeting the safety criteria exist, AB70/SB3 will not stop development of the proposed Wolf River mine. If safe mines do not exist, AB70/SB3 postpones opening the mine until safe technology is developed and proven. The minerals which Exxon and Rio Algom seek to mine will still be there. Why rush ahead, risking the existing and highly lucrative Northwoods tourism industry, which depends not on having a mine to visit, but upon having clean water for fishing, boating, and recreating?

We would appreciate knowing your position on this matter.

Enclosed are more letters from your constituents – sixty-two of them -- who want you to support the Mining Moratorium Bill (SB3/AB 70).

As you know, Wisconsin Citizen Action and its 52,867 individual members statewide strongly support the Mining Moratorium Bill (SB3/AB70). Clean water and pristine rivers are critical not just to the health and well-being of Wisconsin's citizens, but also to the economic prosperity of our state. We believe this legislation lays out reasonable and appropriate criteria to be met before any new metallic sulfide mining operations begin in Wisconsin.

As I testified before your committee last month, Wisconsin Citizen Action opposes AB236. While the intent behind the bill may have been good, AB236 would not in fact provide a sufficient standard of protection for Wisconsin's water. We are also particularly concerned that AB236 would allow a company to use technology which has not been tested in a mining application, much a less a metallic sulfide mining application. We believe that AB70/SB3 is a much more sound option.

We encourage you to reconsider your position on this issue and appreciate your consideration of our views.


