SB 38

This bill was requested by Hugh Harper who is very active in land information board and association issues. He felt that since the Secretaries of DOA, DATCP, DNR and DOT all have a vote on the board, and the fact DOR currently only serves as an advisory member, the law should be changed to give a vote to the Secretary of DOR similar to the other agencies represented.

His main argument is that a major responsibility of DOR is to establish equalized property values. Accurate mapping of tax parcel data is crucial to this process and an area where DOR should be directly involved. **As a voting member on the Land Information Board, DOR will be able to play an active role in furthering land records modernization and the use of land records in promoting effective land use planning.**

Senate Amendment 1 was requested by Senator Chvala due to the concerns of one of his constituents that the balance on the board would be changed if an additional agency person was added. As a result, we drafted the amendment to direct the Governor to appoint a representative of a statewide association whose purposes include support of a network of statewide land information systems. The only one which exists is the Wisconsin Land Information Association but we couldn't identify the association by name since it's private and nonprofit.

The bill received no opposition in the Senate and passed on a voice vote. The Department of Revenue supports the bill as well.
