

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55**

June 29, 2001 – Offered by Representatives BOCK, BLACK and MILLER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 148, line 3: after that line insert:

3 “231q. Page 198, line 14: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001–02 by
4 \$2,093,400 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2002–03 by \$4,239,100 for
5 the purposes for which the appropriation is made.”.

6 **2.** Page 573, line 11: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
7 with page 574, line 12.

8 **3.** Page 576, line 9: delete lines 9 to 13.

9 **4.** Page 663, line 13: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
10 on page 664, line 7, and substitute:

11 “**SECTION 2258d.** 79.01 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 79.01 (1) There is established an account in the general fund entitled the
2 “Expenditure Restraint Program Account”- Account. There shall be appropriated
3 to that account \$25,000,000 in 1991, in 1992, and in 1993; \$42,000,000 in 1994;
4 \$48,000,000 in each year beginning in 1995 and ending in 1999 and; \$57,000,000 in
5 the year 2000 and in the year 2001; \$57,570,000 in 2002; and \$58,145,700 in 2003
6 and in each year thereafter.

7 **SECTION 2280m.** 79.03 (3c) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 79.03 (3c) (f) *Distribution amount.* If the total amounts calculated under pars.
9 (c) to (e) exceed the total amount to be distributed under this subsection, the amount
10 paid to each eligible municipality shall be paid on a prorated basis. The total amount
11 to be distributed under this subsection from s. 20.835 (1) (b) is \$10,000,000 beginning
12 in 1996 and ending in 1999 and; \$11,000,000 in the year 2000 and in the year 2001;
13 \$11,110,000 in 2002; and \$11,221,100 in 2003 and in each year thereafter.

14 **SECTION 2281d.** 79.03 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

15 79.03 (4) In 1991, the total amount to be distributed under ss. 79.03, 79.04, and
16 79.06 from s. 20.835 (1) (d) is \$869,000,000. In 1992, the total amount to be
17 distributed under ss. 79.03, 79.04, and 79.06 from s. 20.835 (1) (d) is \$885,961,300.
18 In 1993, the total amount to be distributed under ss. 79.03, 79.04, and 79.06 from s.
19 20.835 (1) (d) is \$903,680,500. In 1994, the total amounts to be distributed under this
20 section and ss. 79.04 and 79.06 from s. 20.835 (1) (d) are \$746,547,500 to
21 municipalities and \$168,981,800 to counties. In Beginning in 1995 and subsequent
22 years ending in 2001, the total amounts to be distributed under ss. 79.03, 79.04 and
23 79.06 from s. 20.835 (1) (d) are \$761,478,000 to municipalities and \$168,981,800 to
24 counties. In 2002, the total amounts to be distributed under ss. 79.03, 79.04, and
25 79.06 from s. 20.835 (1) (d) are \$769,092,800 to municipalities and \$170,671,600 to

1 counties. In 2003 and subsequent years, the total amounts to be distributed under
2 ss. 79.03, 79.04, and 79.06 from s. 20.835 (1) (d) are \$776,783,700 to municipalities
3 and \$172,378,300 to counties.

4 **SECTION 2281e.** 79.03 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

5 79.03 (5) (a) In 2002 and 2003, each municipality shall receive a shared
6 revenue payment under this section that is equal to the amount of the payment it
7 received in the previous year, multiplied by 101%. In 2004 and in subsequent years,
8 each municipality shall receive a shared revenue payment under this section that is
9 equal to the amount of the payment it received in 2003.

10 (b) The department of revenue shall use the population amounts it used to
11 determine the November 2000, shared revenue payments to municipalities to
12 calculate corrections to such payments in 2001, as provided under s. 79.08. The
13 department of revenue shall use the population amounts it used to estimate
14 payments under s. 79.015 in September 2000, to calculate actual and corrected 2001
15 shared revenue payments to municipalities.”.”

18 “**SECTION 2285n.** 79.058 (3) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

19 79.058 (3) (c) In the year 2000 and ~~subsequent years~~ in 2001, \$20,763,800.

20 **SECTION 2285p.** 79.058 (3) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

21 79.058 (3) (d) In 2002, \$20,971,400.

22 **SECTION 2285r.** 79.058 (3) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

23 79.058 (3) (e) In 2003 and subsequent years, \$21,181,100.”.”

2 with page 671, line 19.

3 **7.** Page 815, line 11: delete lines 11 and 12.

4 **8.** Page 1186, line 10: delete “programs.” and substitute “programs.”.

5 **9.** Page 1186, line 11: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
6 with page 1188, line 5, and substitute:

8 “**SECTION 3225c.** 287.23 (5b) (title) and (intro.) of the statutes are amended to
9 read:

10 287.23 **(5b)** (title) GRANT AWARD FOR 2000 AND 2001. (intro.) The For 2000 and
11 2001, the department shall award a grant under this subsection to each eligible
12 responsible unit that submits a complete grant application under sub. (4) for
13 expenses allowable under sub. (3) (b). The department shall determine the amount
14 of the grants under this subsection as follows:

15 **SECTION 3225f.** 287.23 (5d) of the statutes is created to read:

16 287.23 **(5d)** GRANT AMOUNT FOR YEARS AFTER 2001. (a) Beginning with grants for
17 the year 2002, the department shall award a grant under this subsection to each
18 eligible responsible unit that submits a complete grant application under sub. (4) for
19 expenses allowable under sub. (3) (b).

20 (b) Except as provided in pars. (c), (d), and (e) and sub. (5p), the department
21 shall award an eligible responsible unit a grant under this subsection equal to \$11.80
22 times the population of the responsible unit.

1 (c) A grant under this subsection may not exceed the allowable expenses under
2 sub. (3) (b) that the responsible unit incurred in the year 2 years before the year for
3 which the grant is made.

4 (d) For a county that is the responsible unit for at least 75% of the population
5 of the county, the department shall award a grant under this subsection equal to
6 \$100,000 or the amount determined under par. (a), but not more than the allowable
7 expenses under sub. (3) (b).

8 (e) For grants for the year 2002, the department shall award a grant to a
9 responsible unit that received an award in 2001 that is equal to at least 80% of the
10 amount received in 2001.”.”.
