Current law regulates snwombile crossings that are not located on a public road. Currently only snowmobile organziations, such as snowmobile clubs, may construct a crossing. In order to construct a crossing, the snowmobile organization must obtain a permit from the Department of Natural Resources Fiscal Estimate - The Department of Natural Resources has issued a total of 6 permits for the construction of snowmobile railraod crossings since 1993. Clubs requesting a permit may be charged \$150 for the initial application fee. If the permit request is approved, the club must pay the rail authority \$1,500 to compensate for the cost of constructing the crossing and the use of the snowmobile crossing by snowmbile operators. Although the Department does collect the \$150 application fee, there will be no notable fiscal benefit from collection given the history of less than one permit application per year. It is assumed there will be no mearsurable increase in workload associated with these applications. It is also assumed that there are no local government costs associated with these statutory provisions.
