and prohibits further disclosure once that consent is withdrawn. The bill also makes other changes related to the disclosure of information, including a fine for violating the prohibition from disclosing information without parental consent. Costs to local school districts could increase as a result of this bill. If a school district determines that the disclosure of information would be for commercial or trade use, it would then be required to obtain the written permission from the parent or guardian whose child is affected. Costs are related to the time that staff will devote to mailing parental consent forms and maintaining records. These costs are indeterminable. Other costs associated with this bill are related to forfeitures by school board officers, employees or agents who do not obtain the required consent forms before releasing information. These costs are also estimated to be indeterminable.
