Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2001 LRB 2611 requires law enforcement officers to forward a copy of any traffic citation and/or copy of any accident report to the federal Office of Foreign Missions within the Department of State if a foreign diplomat is involved in the traffic incident. Law enforcement officers are also required to verify the status of the person claiming diplomatic status.

There is no fiscal effect on the State Patrol or local law enforcement agencies in Wisconsin if LRB 2611 is enacted. Though currently impossible to estimate the number of incidents involving foreign diplomats traveling in Wisconsin, it is anticipated that the number will be minimal. The time spent on each incident to verify the identification of the diplomat, to contact the State Department, and to make and submit copies of the citation(s) and/or report(s), will be minimal. Training for law enforcement officers on these procedures can be absorbed within routine training sessions, and costs associated with copying and submitting the citation(s) and/or report(s) can be absorbed by the responsible law enforcement agency and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
