Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation requires voters registering to vote at the polls on Election Day and voters changing their registration at the polls on Election Day to show a Wisconsin driver's license or Wisconsin identification card issued by the Department of Transportation to the election inspectors in order to register and vote. A voter applying for an absentee ballot at the municipal clerk's office must also provide this identification.

The Department of Transportation is required to provide the Wisconsin identification card at no charge to a voter if the voter requests.

At the 2000 general election 160,095 voters (6.17% of the electors voting) voted absentee. Most of these absentee ballots were requested and voted by mail. There are no statistics available on the number of electors that requested an absentee ballot in the municipal clerk's office.

At the 2000 general election 411,545 voters (15.72% of the electors voting) registered to vote at the polls on Election Day or changed their registration at the polls on Election Day.

The costs to implement this legislation include the cost to furnish the Wisconsin identification card at no charge to a voter if the voter requests. There is no reliable information to determine how many voters would request a free identification card.

The Elections Board will incur one-time costs for revising, preparing, printing and distributing forms, information materials, manuals and training materials.
