Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The biennial budget act (1999 Wis. Act 9) provided \$100,000 in grant funds FY 2000-01 to help cattle owners pay for Johne's disease laboratory tests performed for herd classification purposes. Herd owners must file a claim for reimbursement with the department by February 1 of the year following the year in which the herd was classified. The herd owner must submit copies of bills for the laboratory costs charged to the owner. DATCP will reimburse all or part of the claim depending on available funding and number of claims.

This was the first year this program was available. Information about the program was given to many agricultural organizations. Last year DATCP classified approximately 500 herds. All classified herds were sent an application for reimbursement. Of these, 295 applied for reimbursement and approximately \$80,346 of the available \$100,000 will be distributed. We fully expect the number of classified herds to increase annually with a corresponding increase in requests for reimbursement. We also expect that as the information on reimbursement is disseminated by producers and veterinarians the percentage of classified herds requesting reimbursement could increase significantly. While costs for this program were absorbed by the department this year it is unlikely that these costs could be absorbed for any increased participation.

The costs on the attached worksheet only reflect department costs for the dispersement of \$80,346 to 295 producers this year and the proposed \$400,000 increase. Many factors will impact on participation including funds available for reimbursement, increased national awareness of Johnes disease as a herd and animal health problem, market impact of the Wisconsin Johnes classification program and cattle and milk prices.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

As participation in the program increases, we expect agency workload and costs will increase.
