Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill directs the department of administration to pay \$12,600 from its appropriation under 20.505(4)(d), a sum-sufficient GPR appropriation, to Alan and Marlene Sieker as compensation for animals destroyed in September of 1997 by the department of agriculture, trade and consumer protection as part of a bovine tuberculosis control program.

On December 17, 1998, the claims board recommended payment of this claim.
