Warning for first violations of certain underage drinking prohibitions										

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a person who violates the prohibitions against selling or otherwise providing alcohol beverages to anyone younger than the age of 21 is subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$500 if the person has not committed a previous violation in the past 30 months. Also under current law, with certain exceptions, a licensee or permittee who violates provisions restricting the presence of underage person on licensed premises is subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$500.

This bill would allow a law enforcement agency to issue a warning, rather than requiring a forfeiture, for any person who has violated these provisions, if the person had not not been found to have committed, or received a written warning for, a previous violation in the past 30 months.

This bill is not expected to have an effect on state tax revenues.
