## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The cost impact of this legislation, as currently drafted, would have no immediate fiscal impact on the Department of Military Affairs. Upon the formation/implementation of this language, the Department will require additional funding and additional FTE authority for two positions.

Costs of Implementation include:

Director/Administrator: (1FTE) \$ 69,900 (maximum salary)
Personnel, Plans & Ops Manager: (1 FTE) \$ 35,500 (maximum salary)
Fringe Benefits (42.19%) \$ 44,500
Limited Term Employee for start-up \$ 22,000
Fringe for LTE (7.65%) \$ 1,700
Supplies/Insurance/Phone/Travel \$ 35,000

Total first year costs \$208,600 Funding year two \$184,900

Once funding is implemented, the FTE and funding amount will become a part of the Department of Military Affairs' base in future Biennial Budget submissions.
