## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law, a person who intentionally points a firearm at another person may be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned for not more than 9 months or both. This bill increases the maximum term of imprisonment for a person who intentionally points a firearm at a law enforcement officer to 15 years.

It is not known how often such a crime is charged but it is expected that additional court time will be needed because of the increase in penalty from a misdemeanor to a felony. The additional judge, court reporter and court staff time that would be needed is impossible to predict with the data available but it is expected that existing staff would have to absorb the additional workoad. Such costs are borne by both the state and the county.
