Mandatory minimum sentence for juvenile who throws bodily substance in juvenile facility									

## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill establishes a mandatory minimum period of imprisonment of two years for a juvenile who is convicted of throwing a bodily substance at or toward another person while placed in a secured correctional facility, a secure detention facility, a secured child caring institution, or a secured group home. This is similar to other mandatory minimum sentences for offense occurring in these types of facilities.

This should have no fiscal effect on local law enforcement or the Department of Justice.
