Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill establishes a Class E felony penalty for those who threaten to use a biological, chemical or radioactive substance. It also allows courts to order reimbursement for response activities.

It is impossible to predict the number of violations that would occur if this bill is enacted but the number is not expected to be significant. As a result any additional workload that might occur for the circuit courts would have to be absorbed by existing court staff.
