## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Bill Summary: This bill authorizes local units of government to enact ordinances that would totally prohibit the use of personal watercraft or which would limit their use during specific portions of the day, or on specific days of the week. Any such ordinance passed would have to apply to the entire area covered by the local unit of government.

Fiscal Estimate: This change would be expected to result in a higher level of complaints received by both municipal and DNR boat patrols in areas that choose to restrict use of personal watercraft. Complaints are anticipated from citizens who see the prohibited watercraft being used, and from potential users of the personal watercraft who object to the restrictions. However, this increase in complaints could be offset by reduced complaints due to reduced usage of the personal watercraft in these selected areas. The Department assumes that the costs of enforcing these ordinances can be absorbed internally, unless the number of complaints increases dramatically.

DNR Legal Services would likely require additional staff time to deal with appeal hearings and public trust questions from local and state agencies. This time can be absorbed within the existing operating budget.
