While this may be a very common crime, the actual number of cases that would be formally prosecuted would likely be small. This is because law enforcement resources would likely not be concentrated on these cases in comparison to more serious property and personal crimes. Also, it is likely that other resolution mechanisms, such as deferred prosecution, would be used in most situations. Formal prosecution before a judge and jury would likely be used only for a very few serious instances.
