Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 703 requires that the Department shall designate and mark the Route of STH 70 commencing at USH 2/141 in Florence and proceeding westerly to the Wisconsin-Minnesota border in Burnett County as the "Civilian Conservation Corps Heritage Highway." The markers are to be installed at regular intervals along the route, including at appropriate area historical sites.

It is estimated that 8 on-highway signs would be installed in each direction and that 4 additional on-highway signs will be required to direct to signs in 2 off-highway historical sites.

Each of the 16 on-highway signs (8 in each direction) will cost \$340 for a sub-total of 16x\$340 = \$5,440. The 4 directional signs to the off-highway sites will also cost \$340 each for a sub-total of 4x\$340 = \$1,360. The off-highway markers with more descriptive narrative relating to the memorial are estimated at \$2,500 each for a sub-total of 2x\$2,500 = \$5,000.

The wood posts to install the on-highway signs, 2 for each sign at \$18 each will cost (16+4)x2x\$18 for a subtotal = \$720. The supports for the 2 off-highway signs will be \$100 each for a sub-total of 2x2x\$100 = \$400. Installation of the 20 on-highway signs at \$100 each will cost 20x\$100 = \$2,000. Installation of the markers in the 2 off-highway sites will cost 400 each for a sub-total of 2x\$400 = \$800. Total costs to install the 20 on-highway signs and 2 off-highway markers is (5,440+1,360+720+2,000) for on-highway +(5000+400+800) for off-highway = \$15,720.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Annual maintenance costs for the 20 on-highway signs presuming an expected life of 10 years is \$9,520/10 = \$952 per year. Maintenance of the off-highway markers presuming a life of 20 years is estimated at \$6,200/20 = \$310 per year. The total annual maintenance is \$952 + \$310 = \$1,262 per year.
