## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill will not materially change the number of marijuana cases that are brought to District Attorneys' Offices or the work required handling those cases. The bill simply permits a defense based on medical need of the user under limited circumstances and prohibits prosecution of persons having such a qualified medical need for marijuana. Determining whether or not a person who is arrested for possession or use of marijuana will meet the qualifying medical need test will still require a decision by and thus create a workload for the DA office.
