Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would not increase the number of cases handled by the State Public Defender (SPD), but it could add to the duration, complexity, and expense of defending some cases for possession or delivery of marijuana. For example, medical experts might have to be retained by one or both parties to assess the defendant's medical condition.

Although the SPD does not presently maintain statistics on the number of marijuana cases in which the proposed defense might apply, we do not believe that it is a significant number of cases.
