Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill expands eligibility for the AIDS Drug Reimbursement Program (ADRP). Under this bill, individuals whose gross income is between 200% and 300% of poverty will be able to participate in the ADRP, provided there is sufficient federal or program revenue funding available. Federal funding will be provided by a federal grant which is intended to increase eligibility in the program. Program revenue funding is derived from drug rebates from pharmaceutical companies. The Department estimates that when this program is fully operational it will serve an additional 100 clients at a cost of \$250,000 annually. There will be no GPR cost to the Department as a result of this bill.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
