Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

LRB #1-4742/1 - AB783: States the governor would receive an annual salary of \$122,406 during the 2003-2004 biennium.

Governor McCallum's Budget Reform bill, if enacted, proposes a 16.5% spending reduction in FY03 in the Executive Office budget. Approximately 10% of those reductions will be taken from the General Program Operations Appropriation (101-4) and specifically from the salary line. AB783 would assist the Executive Office in reducing expenditures during 2003-2004 by holding the governor's salary at the current level of \$122,406.

If this bill is not enacted, the governor is scheduled to be paid an annual salary of \$131,768. That salary would be absorbed with our our current personnel structure.
