## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would create a Council under the Medical Examining Board.

The fiscal impact would be the cost of travel and per diem for Council members. The cost would be \$1,000 for per diems, \$3,000 for travel expenses, \$1,500 for meals and loding that are direct billed. The implementation for this bill would also necessitate the printing of new applications and code books at a cost of \$500. The agency also anticipates the need for .50 FTE at the Program Assistant 3 level to process application materials.

The total cost needed to implement this legislation would be passed along to credential holders in the form of initial credential and renewal fees.
