**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

SB 110 changes the law on leave for represented state employees to serve as election officials. This bill would make represented employees automatically eligible for such leave without the need to bargain for the leave, unless otherwise provided in a collective bargaining agreement.

SB 110 also makes local government employees eligible for leave to serve as election officials without loss of pay and benefits the same as state employees.

This bill will have no fiscal effect on the Department of Employment Relations.

The Department of Employment Relations has no data to determine if the legislation would have a fiscal effect on local governments.

**Long-Range Fiscal Implications**
