Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The department currently uses as the definition of agriculture the definition of "farming" and "farm premises" contained in s.102.04(3) of Wisconsin Statutes. That definition already considers christmas tree farms as agricultural in nature. We allow minors twelve years of age and older to work up to 50 hours a week (during non-school hours) on a christmas tree farm and, during peak periods, minors may work more hours. Passage of this bill will not increase the number of hours that minors may work on christmas tree farms. Consequently the department expects passage of this legislation not to have any impact on department workload.
