Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill extends the sunset provision for collecting an environmental impact fee when registering for the first time or transfering ownership of a motor vehicle. Currently, when a new vehicle is registered for the first time, or when applying for a new title upon transfer of ownership of a vehicle, the applicant must pay an environmental impact fee of \$6. The fee expires on June 30, 2001. The bill extends the sunset date to September 30, 2003, with an effective date of July 1, 2001.

The bill would continue the current practice for the Department of Transportation, no changes are required to computer systems or forms. In addition, with an effective date of July 1, 2001, there is no gap where the department would have to stop collecting the fee and then restart collecting it on the effective date. Because the status quo is maintained, there is no fiscal impact for the department.
