Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under the current statutes the Tribal Delegates would not be afforded the allocation of resources, such as the payment of salaries and expenses and the provision of staff, offices and supplies that an elected offical receives. Under the bill, the Legislature would be empowered to grant tribal delegates any privileges that are established under the rules. Change of the statutes would be required for allocation of resources to the Tribal Delegates.
