Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would create a new type of license for physical therapist assistants. The agency would require 1.0 FTE at the Program Assistant 1 level to process applications for this license type. The annual salary for a PA 1 is \$20,970 with a fringe cost of \$7,900.

There would also be costs associated with developing, printing and mailing the new application forms. There are currently 4,453 physical therapists licensed in the state of Wisconsin. These costs are projected at \$15 per licensee for a total increase of \$66,795.
