Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The provisions of the bill that pertain to the change in court jurisdiction and weather modification regulation would have no fiscal impact.

The department has not issued any weather modification licenses since 1977, and there is no evidence that any weather modification activities have taken place since then.

The only provision of this bill with any fiscal impact is the synchronization of licenses.

This bill would reduce revenues for FY 01/02 by extending the license period on feed and soil and plant additive licenses. Because of the longer license year during the implementation, the Department would not collect \$31,000 in feed license fees during FY 01/02 and would not collect \$1,000 in soil and plant additive license fees in FY 01/02. Subsequent year revenues would continue at their current rate.
